

Slimbridge Wetland Centre Visual Guide

You will arrive here.

This is the car park at Slimbridge.



One of WWT's teachers will come and say hello to your group.

They will be wearing pink or blue uniforms with a swan on.



The entrance to the centre is either:



Through a door



Through a gate



Walking up a ramp

There are several toilets including accessible toilets.



Doors with this symbol on don't have hand driers, they will have hand towels instead.



There is a Changing Place located just outside the Visitor Centre.



You will see different animals from around the world.
Some of the animals will be in aviaries, some will be in tanks and others will be out in the open.



You might see flamingos. They may be outside or inside depending on the weather.

There may be a strong smell if you go inside the viewing area because of the food they eat.



You can find out more about the animals on the information boards and posts.



The birds sometimes walk on the paths. If they get too close for you, ask us what you can do to help yourself feel less worried.



You might eat your lunch in one of our rooms.

If the weather is nice, you might eat outside in one of our picnic areas.



There are areas that are quieter and calmer.

This includes the Garden of Reflection and the Rain Garden.



There are hides where you can watch the wildlife.



From the Estuary Tower Hide you can see views of the River Severn.



You might get to see a bird demonstration in the Living Wetland Theatre.



There are areas that you can play in if it's in the plan for your day.

These can be a bit louder than other areas of the site.



Wellyboot Land has trampolines, climbing trees, a log tunnel and a basket swing.

Your teacher might ask you to bring a change of clothes if you will be playing in the water!
